Last year the diocese produced a Family Prayer Card, these Prayer Cards were distributed at Mass at the time. As Lent begins, we are offering these cards again. Could we please strongly encourage families at the start of Lent to begin punctuating your day with these short prayers, especially perhaps during meal times. We distributed rosary beads at Christmas could we also encourage, the rosary or even a decade of the rosary daily during Lent. The practice of prayer is a wonderful instrument for bringing peace, comfort and healing into our lives.

LENTEN FILM SERIES

The Castlecourt Hotel is the venue for a Lenten film series on the theme of conversion, starting at 8:00pn and running for six successive Wednesdays, each night stands on its own so feel free to drop in on any of the Wed nights. The films offer a fresh look at faith by examining the lives of Biblical characters. They are presented by Bishop Robert Barron, known as the 'Internet Bishop'.
