Lectio... A way of prayer

Opening Prayer

"Lord Jesus, you who are the Son of the living God, teach me to listen to what you tell me in the Holy Scriptures, and to discover your face there"

The passage of Scripture is read once, slowly:

Take 2/3 minutes to reflect on the passage. Note any phrase, word or image that stands out for you.

The passage is read slowly a second time:

Take a few minutes to ponder the passage again.
Stay with the text: Why do you think the words or image stand out the first time? Is your mind drawn to another part of the text? What do you think God is trying to tell you through the text today?

Consider the Reflection Question:

Take note of any thoughts you have to the question – you may wish

to write down any questions that rose from the text.

Pray

- 1. Take a few minutes and be still and present to God
- 2. Share your thoughts, questions with God.
- 3. Is God speaking to you?

 Remember it may not be a voice you hear but an nudge, a consolation, or an insight. If you are keeping a journal you may wish to write these down.
- 4. When you are done, say a quick prayer thanking God for this time with him.

World Wetlands Day: February 2nd

Wetlands, such as the blanket bogs of Owenduff and Owenboy within the Ballycroy National Park here in Mayo, play a vital role in the world's ecosystem, providing essential protection against climate change, floods, droughts and pollution.

- Wetlands provide habitats for animals and plants and are *the most effective carbon sinks on the planet*.
- More than one billion people depend on wetlands for a living.
- Up to 40% of the world's species live and breed in wetlands.

Over a third of the world's wetlands have disappeared since 1970. They are

disappearing three times faster than forests. *Climate change, urbanisation, pollution, unsustainable use, and invasive species* are threatening the existence of wetlands.
