## OCTOBER – MONTH OF THE ROSARY

This week we celebrated the Feast of Our Lady of the Rosary and as we continue the month of the rosary, we encourage you to pray the rosary in your homes, or out for a walk, or wherever you can. The rosary is recited daily after Mass in Westport and before Mass on Sundays in Drummin. The Legion of Mary have made rosary beads available at the back of Westport church free of charge.

## PRAYING THE ROSARY

You may wish to pray the rosary at home or elsewhere. Here is a guide on how and when to pray each mystery.

1. Make the Sign of the Cross and say the "Apostles' Creed"
2. Say the "Our Father"
3. Say three "Hail Marys" for Faith, Hope, and Charity
4. Say the "Glory Be"
5. Announce the First Mystery and then say the "Our Father"
6. Say ten "Hail Marys" while meditating on the Mystery
7. Say the "Glory Be" (*Optional: Say the "O My Jesus" prayer requested by Mary at Fatima*)
8. Announce the Next Mystery; then say the "Our Father" and repeat these steps (6 through 8) as you continue through the remaining Mysteries.
9. Say the closing prayers: the "Hail Holy Queen" and "Final Prayer"
10. Make the "Sign of the Cross"

Pope Saint John Paul II suggested the recitation of the Rosary as follows: the **JOYFUL** mysteries Monday and Saturday, the **LUMINOUS** on Thursday, the **SORROWFUL** on Tuesday and Friday, and the **GLORIOUS** on Wednesday and Sunday (with this exception; Sundays of Advent and Christmas – the **JOYFUL**; Sundays of Lent – the **SORROWFUL**).
