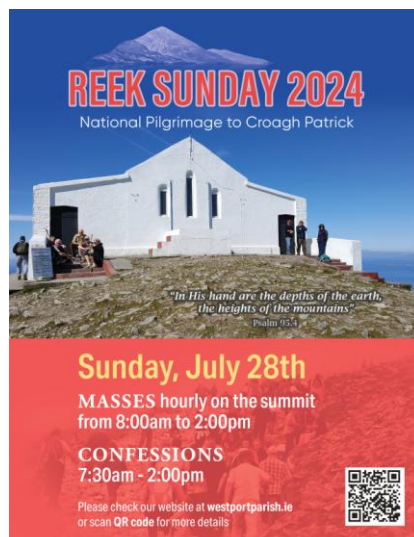
TRADERS ON THE REEK 2024
