#### FACE COVERINGS - LETTER FROM ARCHBISHOP

At this time, the government has not formally made mandatory the wearing of face coverings at Mass or other liturgies. This is, in part, due to the fact we are committed in the document published by the Western Bishops, Nothing Can Separate Us from the Love of God, to maintaining two-metre physical distancing between household groups and strict adherence to all government guidance.

It however remains our responsibility to ensure that our churches are safe places for all who come to pray. It has become increasingly clear that the wearing of face coverings, in conjunction with hand washing etc, is likely to reduce the spread of Coronavirus, thus helping to protect others. Their use is therefore one way in which we can evidence protection for the most vulnerable, support for our health workers and practical love for our neighbours.

Following further guidance from public health authorities, I am recommending and encouraging the use of face coverings at all Masses and other liturgical celebrations in the Archdiocese, along with the ongoing maintenance of two-metre physical distancing.

I take this opportunity to thank you very much for the work you have done in preparing your churches for the resumption of Masses, and I thank members of Pastoral Councils, Stewards, Cleaners, other volunteers, and all who assist in keeping the churches sanitised and safe for all.

- Please do not participate in congregational singing at this time.
- Church doors will open 30 minutes before the start of Mass. PLEASE COME ON TIME.
- Please insofar as possible attend the toilet before leaving home.
- Anybody who is feeling unwell with flu like symptoms should not attend Mass.
- Follow correct respiratory etiquette cover your face while coughing or sneezing.
- Holy Communion should only be received in the hand or in a pyx which can be purchased in McGreevys & Morans.

## GUIDANCE TOR THOSE RETURNING TO CHURCH WITH EFFECT JULY 13<sup>TH</sup> 2020 PLEASE READ CAREFULLY BEFORE ATTENDING CEREMONIES

- There are two separate sections available each taking fifty people.
- Section 1: Enter and leave through James Street door and use the top half of the church.
- Section 2: Enter and leave through Mall doors and use bottom half of church.
- The maximum number permitted at any ceremony is 100.
- As soon as this number is attained there will be no further admission to the church.
- This number does not include priests, choir or volunteers who can be accommodated separately and safely.
- The directions of the stewards **MUST** be followed at all times.
- You may ONLY sit where you are instructed to so.
- A ceremony can only begin when full co operation has been attained.
- This document applies to all ceremonies, scheduled Masses, Baptisms, Weddings & Funerals.
- PLEASE TRY TO BE SEATED TEN MINUTES BEFORE MASS.

#### **GENERAL ARRANGEMENTS**

- The Sunday Obligation remains dispensed with, meaning you do not have to go to Mass on Sunday.
- Parish Live streaming and radio facilities will continue as during the Pandemic.
- While there will be music hopefully from soloists and musicians, full choirs cannot attend initially.
- Please do not participate in congregational singing at this time.
- Church doors will open 30 minutes before the start of Mass.
- Newsletters may be collected as you LEAVE the church.
- There will be no offertory baskets, boxes will continue to be left in church for envelopes.
- Please insofar as possible attend the toilet before leaving home.

#### WHO CAN ATTEND

- We encourage parishioners in Westport to attend Mass on weekdays at 10:00am insofar as possible.
- Weekend Masses should be reserved for those who genuinely cannot attend weekdays.
- A limited amount of seats will be held for families with Masses booked.
- These MUST BE FILLED FIFTEEN MINUTES BEFORE MASS.

#### **COVID PROTECTION / SELF & OTHERS**

- The wearing of masks is STRONGLY ADVISED as part of best practice.
- Anybody who is feeling unwell with flu like symptoms should not attend Mass.
- Follow correct respiratory etiquette cover your face while coughing or sneezing.
- Please comply with the instructions of stewards at all times.
- There is no longer any such thing as your 'usual seat' this will be difficult.
- Those who do not obey the 'stewards' instructions will be asked to leave.

#### **ENTERING AND LEAVING SEATS / CHURCH**

- Entry to the church in Westport will be through the Mall door for bottom half of church and James Street for top half.
- Please sanitize your hands on entering the church.
- Maintain the correct social distance of two metres at all times.
- There must be four metres between each section.
- Stewards will show parishioners to their seats, filling the churches from the top.
- When the church has reached capacity no further members of the congregation will be admitted.
- All members of the congregation are asked to be in their seats five minutes before the start of Mass.
- Congregation will be asked to leave seat by seat using all doors.

#### **RECEIVING HOLY COMMUNION**

- All lay ministers and volunteers will be required to sign a return to work form and complete a checklist.
- Eucharistic Ministers MUST wear provided face coverings and sanitize hands thoroughly.
- For the time being, those who wish to receive Holy Communion are recommended to do so only on the hand.
- Those receiving Holy Communion may also bring their own pyx if they so wish.
- Follow the instructions of the stewards for Holy Communion and stand on only clearly marked socially distanced places.
- One way system only for Holy Communion.
