The first three days of February are always special because they hold rich symbolism and we invite you to enter into it: February 1st – Feast of St. Brigid

There's no shortage of rushes in the west of Ireland and we encourage people this year, along with their families to make their own St. Brigids crosses in their homes. Instructions are available on various YouTube videos.

February 2nd – Presentation of the Lord – Candlemas

On this day we celebrate forty days since the birth of Christ, it is the day on which candles are blessed. Many families like to have candles blessed for their homes. Should you like candles blessed, please bring your candles to the church with your name on them and leave them in one of the seats in the side aisle where you can collect them after they are blessed. In Drummin & Lecanvey candles will be blessed next Sunday. Please leave them on the seats on the back half of these churches. Anybody wishing to leave candles for use in the church should leave them in the basket at the church door.

February 3rd - St. Blaise - Blessing of throats

For those who happen to be in the church for private prayer on this day and wish to have their throats blessed the priests will be hanging round the church throughout the morning and afternoon. Please do not form groups and please bring your own candles which you should hold yourselves.
