#### THINKING OF CHRISTMAS

To be honest when the churches were open it was an absolutely massive struggle for the parish and for parishioners. Even though we strive at all times to do our best, and are deeply grateful to those who give of their valuable time to assist us, as well as the patience of so many parishioners, the greatly reduced capacity meant that we were far from able to accommodate people in the way we would have liked to. The thought of opening up at the same reduced capacity at what is traditionally the busiest time of the year, genuinely fills us with the dread, that not being able to facilitate people in the way we would like poses the risk of taking the good out of Christmas for some people, at the end of what has already been a difficult and disappointing year. Christmas as well as being a Holy time is a very special time, and for so many the two often go hand in hand. In recent years the largest attendance has been at 6:30pm. Family Mass on Christmas eve, and we are hoping that again that this will be the biggest Mass, but this time ONLINE! The Pastoral Council will look at how we can make Christmas liturgies as real within the limitations set before us.

We will be encouraging families in the coming weeks to set up for this. Many homes have 'Smart tvs' which will enable casting, or for those who don't 'Google chromecast' can be installed for about €40. We would suggest that you might consider this along with your list of Christmas decorations this year so as to create a room in the house which you can prepare for Christmas Mass. We hope to have more details next week as we continue to plan as best we can.
