WESTPORT ECO CONGREGATION

As parts of our world experienced rises in sea level, severe flooding and drought and some of the poorest countries in the world who have contributed least to the climate crisis are experiencing large losses and damage from climate impacts they are being left to pay for a crisis not of their making. Greta Thunberg writes in – The Climate Book - many people still think of climate change as “a slow, linear and even rather harmless process” “The climate is not just changing It is breaking down.....We are entering a new era of more dramatic change” she adds. COP27 offers Ireland the opportunity to lead by example: to take responsibility for its role in contributing towards the emissions that are spurring climate breakdown, and to work to advance climate justice. It also offers Ireland the chance to champion the voices of those most impacted, particularly grassroots women who face barriers to participate meaningfully in these negotiations and in climate decisions affecting their lives.”
